8 **Tips and Tricks for Taking Care of Your Hearing Devices** (Webinar)

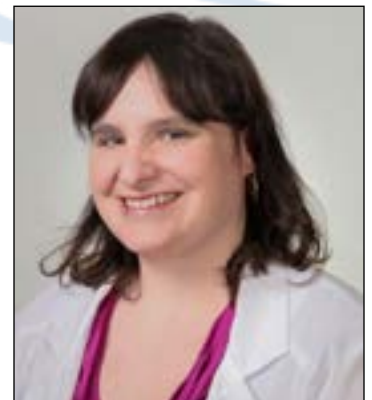
